As we reflect on the past fiscal year, we do so with immense pride and gratitude. FY25 was a year of growth, challenges, and unwavering commitment to our mission. With your support, Food for Others provided food each week to more than 2,400 families and 3,900 students across Fairfax County. We were honored to receive the Moxie Award, recognizing boldness in business; we completed a comprehensive program evaluation to better understand our strengths and opportunities; and we distributed more than 3,108,258 pounds of food - equivalent to 2,590,215 meals - into our community. # 30 Years of Nourishing Neighbors

Food for Others began in 1995 with a simple idea: no neighbor should go hungry. What started as a small, volunteer-led effort under the name Lazarus at the Gate quickly grew into something much larger than anyone imagined. With passion, grit, and a handful of volunteers, Food for Others opened its doors determined to make food accessible to anyone who needed it.

In those early years, neighbors came together to lift one another up. Under the leadership of our first Executive Director, Roxanne Rice, Food for Others became a lifeline. Just two years in, our community helped us distribute over one million pounds of food. Not long after, we began purchasing milk and eggs - staples that remain at the heart of our emergency food program today.

As the years passed, Food for Others evolved alongside the community. A warehouse remodel in 2008 created the space many know today, and new programs soon followed. In 2011, the Power Pack Program was born, ensuring children had food to carry them through the weekend. What began with five schools has grown to 47 - proof of how one small idea, fueled by compassion, can ripple outward to change lives.

The past decade has brought both challenges and transformation. In 2016, Food for Others piloted utilizing the choice-model, laying the groundwork for My Market, which opened in 2023. Along the way, the COVID-19 pandemic forced us to adapt overnight, stretching our reach further into the community as new programs and partnerships emerged under the leadership of Executive Director, Annie Turner. Yet even in uncertainty, our mission held firm: food would be there for those who needed it most.

Today, under the leadership of Executive Director, Deb Haynes, Food for Others is reaching new corners of the community. DoorDash deliveries bring meals to those who cannot come to us. On-site farm stands offer fresh, local produce. And partnerships connect families with resources that go beyond food. With every initiative, our neighbors remain at the center - because Food for Others has always been about more than food; it's about care, dignity, and community.

As we celebrate 30 years, we look back with gratitude and forward with hope. None of this would be possible without the dedication of our supporters - volunteers, donors, and partners who stand with us. Today, more than 105,000 of our neighbors in Fairfax County face food insecurity. The need is great, but so is the heart of this community. And as the world continues to change, one thing remains constant: Food for Others will be here, sharing food from our table to yours.
